
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Family Participation

At Kersbrook Primary School we recognise that education is one of the major vehicles for the development of capabilities for active participation in civic life.

We have created structures and processes that give an authentic voice to all in the school community. Students are encouraged to have a say in their learning and parents are provided with opportunities to participate in their child's education and to play a role in the life of the school.

Out of School Hours Care

OSHC is available to families from 3pm to 6 pm on school days for a reasonable fee of \$18 per session (as at August 2017). OSHC provides professional after school care for students. Families may be eligible for a Child Care Rebate to help cover the cost.

Playgroup

Playgroup meets each Wednesday morning from 9am during school term. It is a friendly and relaxed environment for parents and caregivers to meet up and socialise, share some time together and for the children to meet others and play. It is a great introduction to school and allows children to become familiar with the environment and people before they start school.



Our School

We are very fortunate to be situated in a beautiful part of the hills with a large oval to host sporting activities, clinics and our annual Auction. Our playground areas and equipment is well utilized by our students and encourage the development of balance, co-ordination, strength and imagination. We have a tennis/basketball court as well as many shaded areas with pleasant gardens and trees. We have specialised areas for nature play and also vegetable gardens.

Our Library is well resourced and we encourage reading for pleasure as well as for academic success. We celebrate a love of literacy with the Premier's Reading Challenge, Books Fairs and National Simultaneous Storytime. Our school Assemblies are also held in the Library on Wednesdays, 3 times each term.
