

School Times

Arrival time for school in the morning is between 8.25am and 8.45am. School starts at 8.45am. Parents/Caregivers are reminded that the morning yard duty does not begin until 8.25am. School finishes at 3.00pm each day and Teachers will be on duty until 3.20 if required.

Catastrophic Fire Risk Notification

If a day is declared *Catastrophic* due to bushfire or storm risk, the school will be closed and no staff or students will be on site.



The school will inform you of closures as soon as possible so that you can make arrangements for the care of your children. We strongly urge parents to consider how your children will be cared for on these days before the event. Normally the Bureau of Meteorology declares the risk at about 4pm the day before and it is widely broadcast in media and on websites.

Student Health and Medications

Your child's health is important so please let us know if your child has a health issue or allergy.

Student medication must be lodged at the front office with a Medication Agreement usually from your GP or Healthcare Provider. Staff are unable to administer medication without following Department for Education procedures. Please do not send students to school with medications in their bag, even Panadol. If your child has Asthma, please provide an Asthma Management Plan. Students may carry and administer their own Asthma Medication if that is part of their plan but their teacher and staff need to be aware of this.

Attendance and Family Holidays

We understand that there are times when families need to take their leave out of the school holiday period resulting in students being absent during the school term. Although this is not desirable or the best option for student learning we try to accommodate these requests.

Parents are required to submit a request for an Exemption on the official form, in writing if they know that their children will be away from school for more than 3 days. These forms are available from the Front Office.

If parents expect to be away for periods longer than 1 month then the application needs to be approved well in advance of the leave dates. These forms are part of the way that all Department for Education schools are required to monitor attendance.

Absences

If your child is ill or absent for any reason you are required to contact the school by phone, with a short written note, e-mail, Dojo or SchoolStream explaining the absence. Departmental guidelines require us to keep records about student attendance and absences. We appreciate your cooperation in this work.

Late Arrivals and Early Departures

It is a legal requirement that all students are accounted for on site and we ask that you come to the front office to sign your child in if late or sign them out if you need to collect your child during the day. We then know who is collecting children and have accurate records about children's attendance and absences. Importantly for any unlikely emergency that arises we need to have accurate documentation of who is on site at all times. Parents are encouraged to schedule appointments outside of school hours when possible.


