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Dear Students, Parents and Caregivers,

Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD)

All schools are required to collect information about the numbers of students that they provide adjustments to under the Disability Discrimination Act (1992) and Disability Standards of Education (2005). From 2018, this data will be used as the basis for national funding.

The NCCD involves the collection of;

- the number of students receiving adjustments to enable them to participate in education on the same basis as other students
- the level of adjustment provided to students
- student's type of disability if known

Under the model the definition of disability is broad and includes learning difficulties, health and mental health conditions.

If your child is identified for inclusion in the Collection, the required information will be included in this year's data collection.

WHAT'S HAPPENING IN ROOM 3?

MATHEMATICS

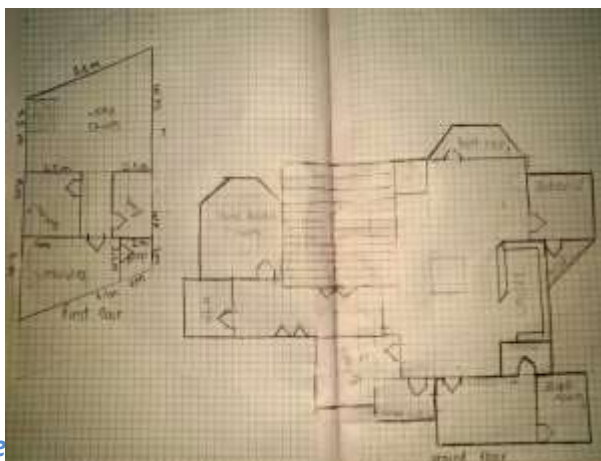
This term, room 3 has been focusing on Measurement and Geometry, in particular shape, area and perimeter. We have been busy creating regular and irregular two-dimensional shapes in the classroom and using our problem solving skills to determine the area of these shapes.

Learning activities have included creating 'Tetris' style shapes and calculating the area and perimeter.



Our project in Mathematics is to design a 'Dream House Floorplan', including a variety of two-dimensional shapes. There are multiple tasks within the project which allow students to demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of the concepts taught through real-world contexts. Students are currently enjoying the designing stage of the project before moving on to the next task of calculating the perimeter to fit skirting boards into their

houses.
