WHAT'S HAPPENED IN ROOM 3 THIS TERM!


READING COMPREHENSION


During Silent Sustained Reading in room 3, students are required to respond to their reading in a variety of ways. This term, we have adapted a new approach to sharing with our peers and summarising what we have read. This is through Charades! Students volunteer to stand in front of the class and re-enact a scene from their novel. Peers within the class then take turns to guess what is happening.

During week 9, our focus with Reading Comprehension was Visualising. After reading, students were asked to visualise and draw an image of a scene in their novel. From this, we collated the pieces and joined them to make a 'Honeycomb Story Board' in the classroom.

3D SHAPES AND SHADING

For the past three weeks, room 3 have been exploring 3D shapes and using lead pencil to shade. Our assessment task was to create a 3D shape tower using at least four different shapes and having a total of at least seven shapes on our page. We had to focus on making sure our lines were straight, the shading showed dark, medium and light (with a light source), and our shapes were evenly distributed throughout the page.
